

UVic Dormitory FAQ Sheet 2024

ELC Dormitory Support Instagram Page:

Join our Instagram page for helpful information and a place to ask questions outside of ELC business hours. This group is exclusively for ELC students living in the dorms. During your orientation, you'll receive a QR code to follow this account.

What's Included:

- Single Rooms: Each room has a bed (with sheets, blankets, and pillows), a dresser, desk, and mirror.
- Bathrooms: You'll have either a single or shared bathroom with showers, toilets, sinks, mirrors, and toilet paper. Remember to bring your own bath and hand towels.
- Wi-Fi Access: Connect to Wi-Fi using your UVic Netlink login and password.
- ONECard with Meal Plan: Enjoy three meals per day with your ONECard. You can add money to your ONECard at the ONECard Office located inside Jamie Cassels Centre.

General Information:

- Check-In and Check-Out:
 - Check-in starts at 3:00 PM on the day before your program begins (see UVic Maps). <u>bit.ly/uvic-maps</u>
 - Check-out is by 11:00 AM on the day after your program ends.

• Dormitory Setup:

- Dorm buildings have mixed language groups.
- Each wing of the building is divided by gender.
- o Shared bathrooms are also divided by gender.

Language Zones:

Public areas like lounges and hallways are English-only zones.

• UVic Residence Services:

- Available 24/7 at the Craigdarroch Office Building.
- Visit for:
 - Lost keys

- Laundry cards
- Emergency laundry soap
- Borrowing irons, blankets, and pillows

General Information (continued):

• Cultural Assistants (CAs):

o CAs live in the dorms to provide support.

• Campus Security:

o Available 24/7 (call 250-721-7599) for emergencies.

• Laundry Facilities:

- Each building has on-site laundry facilities.
- Use a card from Residence Services or the Coinamatic CP app to operate the machines.
- Note: The Coinamatic CP app doesn't accept all debit cards

• Clean Linen Exchange:

UVic Residence Services provides fresh sheets and pillowcases twice a week.

Garbage and Recycling:

Facilities are available in each building.

• Vacuum Cleaners:

Borrow vacuum cleaners from each building.

Community Standards:

• Follow the ELC Community Living Handbook.

• Smoking:

- Allowed only in designated outdoor areas with red benches.
- No smoking indoors, including roofs and balconies.

• Alcohol:

- o Permitted in your room if you're 19 or older.
- Not allowed in public areas (lounges and outdoor spaces).

• Quiet Time:

- Sunday to Thursday: 9:00 PM to 8:00 AM
- o Friday to Saturday: 12:00 AM to 10:00 AM

• Rules and Laws:

 Breaking rules or laws in UVic Dormitories may result in removal from the dorms and your program.
