- want an intensive schedule with flexible entry dates (Monthly English)
- want to study during a scheduled break at their home university (Monthly English or Summer Language and Culture)
- are motivated to complete the program as professional development

General English (long-term)

INTENSIVE ENGLISH (ELPI)

- Start dates: January, April, September
- **Duration:** 12 weeks, full-time
- Levels: Upper Beginner to Advanced
- Integrated skills curriculum builds general English skills in all 4 language areas
- Accommodation & Meals: Homestay
- Tuition: \$4500 CAD

ELPI - SUMMER

- Start date: July
- **Duration:** 10 weeks, full-time
- Levels: Upper Beginner to Advanced
- Integrated skills curriculum builds general English skills in all 4 language areas
- Accommodation & Meals: Homestay
- **Tuition:** \$3750 CAD





General English (short-term)

MONTHLY ENGLISH

- Start dates: September March
- Duration: 4 weeks, full-time
- Levels: Upper Beginner to Advanced
- "English through themes" curriculum: Canada, Global Issues, Society & Culture
- Accommodation & Meals: Homestay
- **Tuition:** \$1,850 CAD

SUMMER LANGUAGE + CULTURE

- Start date: June, July, August
- **Duration:** 3-6 weeks, full-time
- Levels: Upper Beginner to Advanced
- "Integrated skills" curriculum builds general English skills in all 4 language areas
- Accommodation & Meals: Homestay (June);
 UVic Dormitory (July and August)
- **Tuition (4wks):** \$1950 CAD





Academic English: Things to Know

These programs are for students who:

- need an advanced level of academic English to meet the language requirement for entry to UVic degree or professional program
- want to focus on specific skills like academic writing, reports, essays, etc.
- are motivated to complete the program as professional development
- may receive credit at their home university for intensive English studies abroad

- University Admission Preparation (oncampus or online)
- University Admission Preparation and Canadian Studies (on-campus)
- UVic Pathway Program (on-campus)





Intensive English (ELPI): Academic

ON-CAMPUS (ELPI)

- Start dates: January, April, September
- **Duration:** 12 weeks, full-time
- Levels: Upper Beginner to Advanced; eligible for UVic Preliminary Admission (<5.5 IELTS)
- Integrated skills curriculum builds academic English skills in all 4 language areas
- Accommodation & Meals: Homestay
- Tuition: \$4500 CAD

ONLINE (ELPI-O)

- Start dates: January, April, September
- **Duration**: 11 weeks, full-time
- Hours: 200 hours total (~20 / week)
- Levels: Intermediate to Advanced; eligible for UVic Preliminary Admission (<5.5 IELTS)
- Blended curriculum features synchronous and a-synchronous activities to build academic English skills in all 4 language areas
- **Tuition**: \$3,295 CAD





University Admission Preparation (UAP)

ON-CAMPUS (UAP)

Start Dates: January, April, September

Duration: 12 weeks

Hours: 260 hours total (20/week)

English entry level: IELTS 6 (no section < 5.5);
 eligible for Conditional Admission

 Successful completion satisfies UVic's English entry requirement for degree programs

• **Tuition**: \$4,250 CAD

ONLINE (UAP-O)

• Start Date: July

Duration: 6 weeks

• **Hours:** 100 hours total (15-20/week)

• English entry level: IELTS 6 (no section < 5.5); eligible for Conditional Admission

• Successful completion satisfies UVic's English entry requirement for degree programs

• **Tuition:** \$3,200 CAD





UVic Pathway Program

A specialized first-year undergraduate program for students wishing to complete English AND credit courses at the same time.

- Starts in: September each year
- 2 Stream options: Social Sciences and Science/Engineering
- English entry level: IELTS 5.5 (no section below 5)
- **Format:** English classes + first-year credit courses
- Student support: Specialized tutorials, labs and workshops
- **Credit:** 10.5 first-year UVic degree credits
- Accommodation: Homestay or UVic Dormitories







Teacher Training: Things to Know

These programs are for:

- Non-native English speakers seeking professional development in the field of education
- In-service educators teaching at the primary, secondary and post-secondary levels
- Educators who want to build capacity refresh and/or expand methodology to teach English or teach other topics in English

• **Dates:** July 8 – 26, 2024

Duration: 3 weeks, full-time

• Instructional hours: 60

Level: Advanced (IELTS 5.5 or equivalent)

Content:

- formal classroom instruction
- professional development workshops
- socio-cultural activities
- Accommodation: UVic Dormitories







Teaching English as a Foreign Language (TEFL)

• **Dates:** July 29 – August 16, 2024

• **Duration:** 3 weeks, full-time

• Instructional hours: 60

Level: Advanced (IELTS 6 or equivalent)

Content:

- formal classroom instruction
- professional development workshops
- micro-teachings
- Accommodation: UVic Dormitories







Application Process for ELC Programs

Steps

- ✓ Submit an online application form *via your*Continuing Studies account.
- √ (If choosing Homestay accommodation, you will be directed to a Homestay application, after submitting your program application)
- ✓ Pay non-refundable fees and deposits
- ✓ Receive Letter of Acceptance by email
- ✓ Apply for the appropriate visa (if applicable)
- ✓ Pay the tuition balance and student services fees 5 weeks before the program start date.

Admission Requirements

To qualify, candidates must provide:

- A transcript showing a minimum of high school completion.
- (Mature applicants who do not meet this requirement may also be considered on the basis of minimum five years' work experience and must provide a resume.)
- Two years of professional, full-time work experience (or post-secondary education) is recommended. This can be demonstrated on a CV / resume.
- Meet English Proficiency requirement (see next slide)

All correspondence for applications submitted by an agency will be with the agent





English Proficiency Requirement

International students must provide proof of English proficiency.

Accepted proof of English Proficiency (any one of the following):

- Transcript showing graduation from a Canadian secondary school
- Four years of full-time academic studies in which all language of instruction is English at a high school or post-secondary institution
- Successful completion of a recognized degree program from an accredited university in which all instruction is in English, in a recognized English-speaking country

- IELTS (academic) 6.0 overall (no sub-score < 5.5)
- TOEFL IBT 79 (no sub-score less than 17)
- UVic <u>Intensive English (ELPI)</u> level 570*
- Successful completion of approved English partner pathway level

*Students may qualify for conditional admission if registered in the UVic Intensive English (ELPI) program.





Application Process for Business Programs

Steps

- ✓ Submit an online application form *via your Continuing Studies account*
- ✓ Upload English Proficiency proof and secondary school transcript of grades.
- ✓ Pay the \$300 application fee.
- ✓ Once paid, admission staff will follow up to confirm application under review.
- ✓ If all requirements are met, admission staff emails a payment link to pay the \$3,500 deposit must be paid within 3 weeks to accept offer.
- ✓ Once deposit is paid, admission staff emails the acceptance welcome package.

Application Process: Conditional Admission


For students who satisfy all requirements <u>except</u> for English proficiency:

- 1. Submit the Business application, indicating student will apply to the ELC's Intensive English (ELPI) program.
- 2. We will charge \$300 business application fee, checking documents, ensuring that you meet the education requirement and advise you to apply for the ELPI program. (You can also submit the ELC application *before* we reach out to you, which will speed up the process).
- 3. Once we have received the ELPI application, we will process that application, charging the required fees, and issue you the ELC acceptance documents.
- 4. We will then go back to your CBA or DBA application and send you the acceptance deposit email to pay the \$3,500 program deposit.
- 5. Once the program deposit has been received, will proceed in processing the application, issuing you the Conditional CBA or DBA acceptance email.
