The Division of Continuing Studies in collaboration with the Faculties of Humanities, Social Sciences, and Fine Arts offers the Canadian Studies program. CS 101, *Introduction to Canadian Culture*

An introduction to the multidisciplinary study of cultural structures and expressions in Canada, including such forms as literature, the fine arts, mass media and communications. This course is open to all undergraduate students as well as to students in the Canadian Studies diploma program and to non-credit students.

One section of CS 101 (1.5 units) will be offered on Mondays and Wednesdays from 4:30 pm to 5:50 pm

Qualifications:

Candidates must have teaching experience at the undergraduate level and should have a background in one or more of the following areas: Canadian literature and the arts, Canadian cultural studies, Canadian social issues, Canadian history, Canadian politics, Indigenous Studies. Preference will be given to applicants with a PhD and a combination of expertise and experience appropriate to the course.

To Apply:

Interested applicants should submit a letter of interest along with their resumes and a teaching dossier by email to Liz Bowman, Program Coordinator, Division of Continuing Studies, University of Victoria at csdp@uvic.ca no later than **Friday, March 31, 2023 at 4:30pm**. The letter of interest should indicate what qualifications prepare you for teaching this particular course. All qualified candidates are encouraged to apply; however, in accordance with Canadian Immigration requirements, Canadian citizens and permanent residents will be given priority.
