How to Apply

- 1. Select your program(s) on the Program Selection list on page 3.
- 2. Complete and sign the Program Application form (pages 2–4) and the Homestay Application form (pages 5–7) if applicable.
- 3. Complete the Payment Information form (page 8) to submit the following non-refundable fees with your application:
 - Application Fee: \$150 (paid only once, even if you register for more than one program)
 - Deposit: \$350 per program (part of the tuition fee, not an additional cost)
 - UVic Homestay Application Fee (if applicable): \$300

5. You will receive a Letter of Acceptance by email once we have processed your application (with completed, signed forms and payment information). Please wait for your Letter of Acceptance before making travel plans.

Admission Requirements

To be eligible for admission to an ELC program, you must:

- Be 18 years or older by the start date of your program.
- Have demonstrated your basic knowledge of English, by completing the ELC's online test (uvic.ca/elc/testing).

Application Fee and Tuition Payment

- Application fees and deposits are due upon registration, along with the completed application forms. The ELC cannot process applications without receiving these fees see page 8 for details.
- The deadline for full payment of tuition and student services fees is 5 weeks before the program start date. A \$100 late payment fee may be charged if tuition fees are paid late.
- Students who have not paid their tuition fees in full by the program start date are not able to attend classes until their fees have been paid in full.

Refunds

- The \$150 program application fee, \$300 homestay application fee and \$350 per program deposit(s) are non-refundable.
- No refund of tuition is possible after the program start date.

Prior to starting your program, if your visa application is denied by the Canadian Embassy, we can refund the \$350 deposit, tuition (if applicable) and the \$300 Homestay fee.

To receive a refund, students must inform the ELC before the program starts and provide Canadian Embassy documentation.

During the ELC program, in the case of extreme illness, students may receive a partial refund if they produce a doctor's note stating they are too ill to continue studying in their ELC program.

There is a \$250 charge for dormitory accommodation cancelled one week prior to the program start date.

Transfers

- If your visa is denied, you may transfer your \$350 program deposit to a future program by paying a non-refundable \$100 transfer fee. You must give the ELC written notification of your cancellation before the program starts, and request the transfer within one month, for a program beginning within one year of cancellation.
- Students are only permitted to transfer to future programs once. If your visa is denied a second time, you will need to submit a new application with another deposit and application fee.
- Students already in Canada cannot transfer fees between programs unless an emergency situation requires them to return home. In these cases, students must provide the ELC with a doctor's note and proof of a return air ticket to their home country. This process is subject to an additional \$100 transfer fee, and approval by the ELC Director.

After You Apply:

- UVic Homestay staff will check your application to make sure that you have included the **Payment Information** form (page 8). We cannot process your Homestay application without the Homestay application fee.
- UVic Homestay staff will use the information you have provided on the application form to match you with a local host, taking into consideration both your needs and those of the Homestay host. Health concerns or issues are prioritized for matches. While our program does its best to match a student's preferences, we cannot guarantee that these will be met.
- Once matched, our UVic Homestay staff will send you a placement contract, stating the dates of your Homestay contract as well as information about your Homestay host, including their contact information.
- You will receive your Homestay contract within 2-3 weeks of your program start date (or sometimes earlier, depending when you apply). Please contact your Homestay host as soon as you receive your contract, so you can get to know them and share your flight arrival details.
- Your first Homestay payment (\$950) will be due upon arrival in Victoria, paid directly to your Homestay host.
