5. Arrange for your final official transcript to be sent when it's available. The final document deadline is Aug. 1, 2023.

- 6. You will be notified by email once you have been accepted into the program. The original Letter of Acceptance will be sent by FedEx courier. We will send you a Letter of Acceptance, receipt and further program information by email and FedEx courier to confirm your registration.
- 7. The first installment must be paid before the payment due date of July 31, 2023. If payment is not received before the deadline, your registration may be cancelled. Students are not permitted to attend class if their account is not up to date.
- 8. Contact the Canadian Embassy or Consulate in your country to determine what documents are needed to apply for a study permit. It is the student's responsibility to obtain a study permit for the duration of the program. - They will submit their Homestay application form and non-refundable Homestay application fee by the deadline date as outlined above.
- They will be 18 years of age by the day they begin Homestay. Applicants under the age of 19 must also have the signature of their parent or guardian. Please Note: In carrying out this agreement, the University will communicate directly with the student, not with the parent or guardian.
- They understand that UVic Homestay places students with local hosts of diverse backgrounds, life experiences and world views.
- They understand that UVic Homestay will select a host based on the information provided on their Homestay application form and that there is no guarantee that all of their personal preferences will be met.
- They have read, fully understand and agree to abide by the UVic Homestay Student Guidelines: uvic.ca/elc/homestay-student-guidelines
- ✓ The Homestay contract with the host is for the duration of their term(s).
- ✓ They must be in full-time studies in order to be in the Homestay program.

- UVic Homestay staff will check your application to make sure that you have included the **Payment Information** form (page 8). We cannot process your Homestay application without the Homestay application fee.
- UVic Homestay staff will use the information you have provided on the application form to match you with a local host, taking into consideration both your needs and those of the Homestay host. Health concerns or issues are prioritized for matches. While our program does its best to match a student's preferences, we cannot guarantee that these will be met.
- Once matched, our UVic Homestay staff will send you a placement contract, stating the dates of your Homestay contract as well as information about your Homestay host, including their contact information.
- You will receive your Homestay contract within 2-3 weeks of your program start date (or sometimes earlier, depending when you apply).
 Please contact your Homestay host as soon as you receive your contract, so you can get to know them and share your flight arrival details.
- Your first Homestay payment (\$1260) will be due upon arrival in Victoria, paid directly to your Homestay host.

- Tuition fees for upcoming terms are refundable, less application fees and deposit, for registrations canceled before the first day of each term. See above for term start dates.
- If the Canadian Embassy rejects the application for a Study Permit, the ELC will refund the \$1000 deposit and the \$300 homestay application fee. The ELC must be informed before the program start date. Copies of documentation from the Embassy will be required.

 If a student applies but is not academically admissible for Preliminary Admission, they will receive a full refund of tuition and deposit. Students who do not submit required documentation are not eligible for a refund. Application fees are non-refundable.

Note: ALL final documents need to be received in order to confirm admission status.
