

Guidelines for Gaokao Report Submission

Undergraduate Admissions at the University of Victoria accepts Gaokao scores **only** from CHESICC (China Higher Education Student Information).

Applicants must:

1. Upload or email a copy of Gaokao verification report issued by CHESICC to your admission assistant by the deadline indicated in your admission checklist.
2. Include your UVic student number (V00xxxxxx) in the email.

Further Information:

1. Applicants who complete the Chinese high school curriculum but do not write the Gaokao must submit either SAT or ACT scores.
2. Submission of an unofficial Gaokao report (e.g. a report from a local Educational Examinations Authority, a notarised report, an online score screenshot or a copy of the report from the school) may be used for preliminary evaluation only.
3. Applicants may also be required to submit an original copy of the Gaokao Verification Report in person to the Undergraduate Admissions Office upon arrival.
