

# UVic Residence FAQ Sheet

## What's Included:

- Single rooms with beds (sheets, blankets and pillows), dresser, desk and mirror.
- Shared bathrooms with showers, toilets, sinks, mirrors and toilet paper. Students must bring their own bath and hand towels. There are NO towels in the bathrooms.
- Free Wi-Fi which can be accessed using UVic Netlink account.
- OneCard with meal plan for 2-3 meals per day. Adding money to OneCards can be done at the OneCard Office located inside University Centre.

## What to Know:

- Dormitory buildings have mixed nationalities and each wing of the building is divided by gender. Bathrooms are also divided by gender.
- English in public areas such as dormitory lounges.
- UVic Housing Office is available 24 hours a day/7 days a week. They can assist in cases of lock outs and lost keys. They also sell laundry soap and laundry cards. Irons are available in each laundry room.
- On-site laundry facilities are located in each building or residence area. Students must purchase a card from the Housing Office and put money on it in order to operate laundry machines.
- Live-in Cultural Assistants provide student support.
- Campus Security is available 24 hours a day/7 days a week in case of emergency.
- UVic Residences provides a clean linen exchange for sheets and pillow cases once per week on a designated day.
- Garbage and recycling facilities are available outside the residence buildings. Vacuum cleaners and a courtesy phone (local calls only) are available in specified areas throughout residence.

## RULES

- No smoking in buildings including roof and balconies (it's the law). Smoking is permitted outside in designated areas with red benches.
- No alcohol in public areas (it's the law) – including lounges and outside. If students are 19 years or older, they can drink in their room with the door closed.
- Quiet time in residences is Sunday-Thursday 9:00pm-8:00am and Friday and Saturday from 12:00am-10:00am.
- If students break the laws regarding smoking and drinking alcohol, they can be asked to leave UVic dormitories.
