Community Arts Instructor

The Division of Continuing Studies at the University of Victoria for many years has been offering a broad range of arts courses to meet the needs of community learners. This includes courses in photography, drawing, painting, design, music, theatre, writing, art history, and more. The Division of Continuing Studies invites applications for instructors for courses this winter, 2023. These classes are part of non-credit arts programming accessed by members of the community looking to gain new knowledge, skills and explore the creative process. In order to keep our fees reasonable for our community learners, we are able to offer a rate of \$60 for each instructional hour.

In particular, we are looking for instructors in the following areas:

- Art History
- Visual Arts
- Non-fiction Writing

Courses proposed can be offered online or in person, and we will consider individual workshops, workshop series as well as courses running for 3 to 10 weeks in duration.

The Division of Continuing Studies is particularly interested in developing long-term relationships with instructors who have high professional standards, excellent communication skills, and a commitment to creating learning experiences immersed in adult education principles.

Preferred requirements

Applicants must be located within Canada to deliver this course and should have:

- a bachelor's degree in Fine Arts or in the field of education;
- excellent interpersonal, communication, and facilitation skills;
- previous teaching experience;
- instructional experience with adult or non-traditional learners is considered an asset.
